

COLORADO CLOWNS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Colorado Clowns has a general scholarship fund which allows the board to award two scholarship per year to any member in good standing. The value of the scholarship is up to but not to exceed \$150.00 and may be applied to any class or program that will advance their clowning skills (this might include some of the following programs or classes) Clown camp, a convention or seminar, classes is ballooning, magic, face painting, or improve. Scholarships will only cover class or program fees but no other expenses. (IF the class or program the applicant is applying for is less than \$150.00, then the scholarship will only cover the cost of that class or program; if more than \$150.00 then the scholarship will only cover up to \$150.00) If a board member wants to apply they will not be able to judge/vote for the applicants, and the scholarship chair would then appoint another member to that voting position.

The scholarship winner will need to show proof of registration for the class or program or receipt of payment. A check from Colorado Clowns to the program's business office is preferred; reimbursement will go to the winner if registration has already been paid before the scholarship is awarded. If you register and pay for a program after you have received the scholarship, you must submit your receipt within 30 days of registration to be reimbursed for your award. Scholarship winners will be required to write an article for the Clown-O-Gram newsletter and give a short demo or talk at one of our monthly meetings within four months after using the scholarship. Winners will not be eligible to apply again for three years.

A scholarship recipient, who for some reason does not attend the educational program they applied for, will have to reimburse the club for any money the alley has paid on their behalf, no later than the December meeting of the year in which the scholarship was awarded. No money will be awarded if the club does not have proof of registration or a receipt for payment to their program by December of year in which they were awarded the scholarship.

To apply, in 200 words or less, describe or name the educational program you would like to attend, how it will advance your clowning, how your winning the scholarship will benefit the alley, and why you deserve to win. Mail your essay unsigned (so the board can decide on the merit of the application alone) in a business size envelope to:
